Age as at 31 August	Overall distribution across age bands is consistent between 2018/19 and 2019/20, with majority of
(of academic year)	students being between 20 and 24 years old.
Gender	The gender split remains significantly weighted to female, with almost 79% of the student population for academic years 2018/19 and 2019/20 being female.
Ethnicity	The split across broad ethnic group (i.e. BAME and White) has remained consistent with majority (almost 93%) of WUC's student population being white.
Disability	The proportion of HE students with a declared disability has increased by over 10 percentage points between 2015/16 and 2019/20, from 18% in 2015/16 to 28.3% in 2019/20.
