Marshal Papworth Scholarship

The Marshal Papworth Scholarships are designed to support postgraduate students from developing countries studying land based courses such as Horticulture and Agriculture. The scholarship is made possible by the generosity of the late Marshall Papworth, an English farmer and member of the East of England Agricultural Society.

To be eligible for the scholarship application process, students must have made a successful application for postgraduate study and hold an unconditional offer from the University College. This is a prerequisite for the scholarship application. Students are encouraged to make the applications for their chosen master's course in the preceding autumn to their intended year of study.
